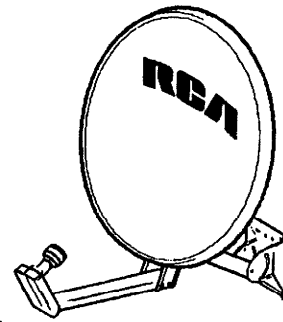


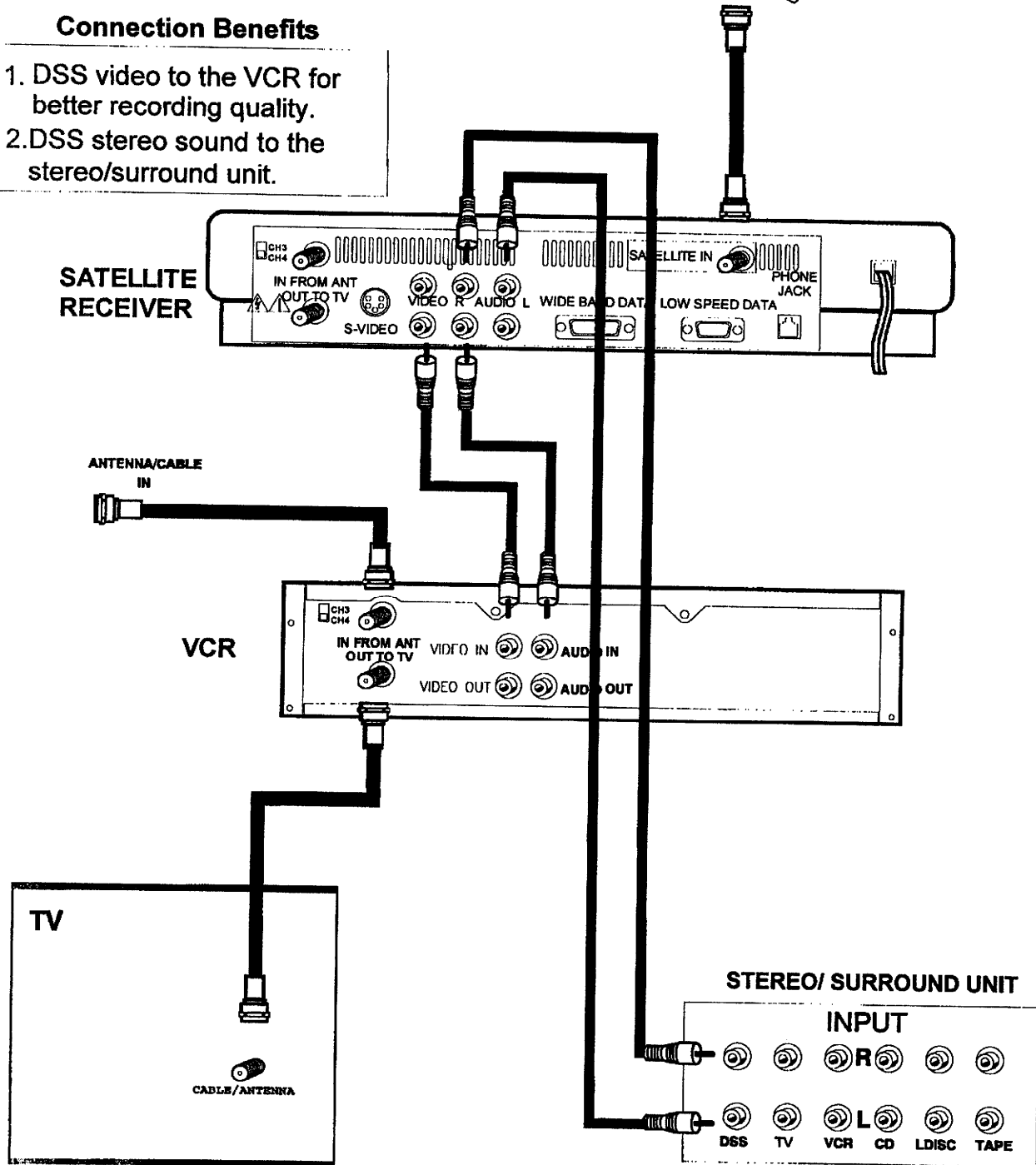
Connection Restrictions

1. This connection requires a dual Audio/Video output on the DSS receiver.
2. No stereo recording. (VCR limitation)
3. Stereo/ surround unit must be on for stereo sound.
4. No stereo sound to the TV.
5. Cannot record antenna/cable when viewing DSS.
6. VCR must be on to view DSS.



Connection Benefits

1. DSS video to the VCR for better recording quality.
2. DSS stereo sound to the stereo/surround unit.

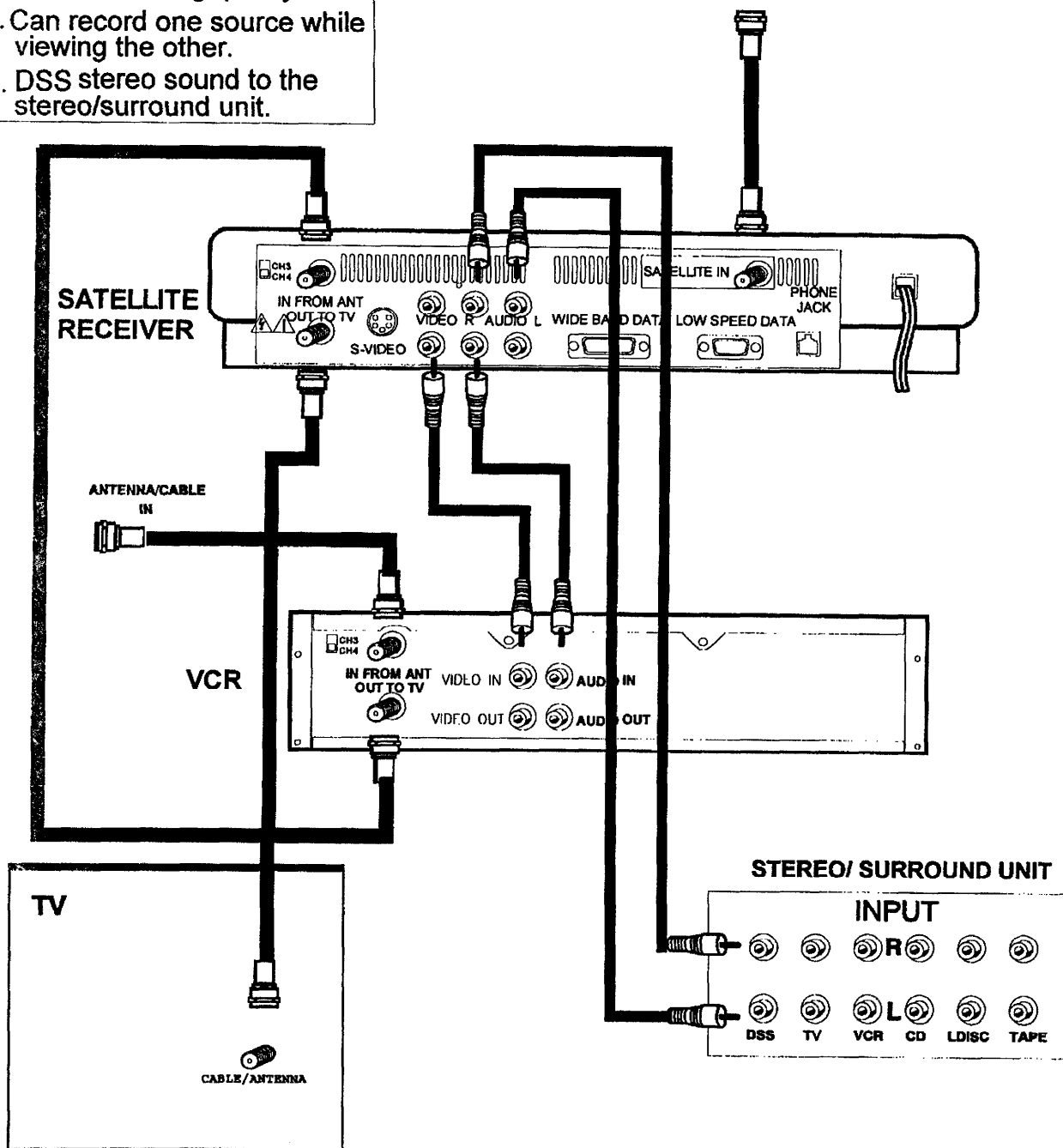
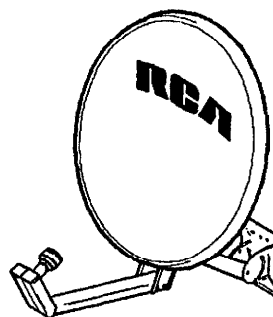


Connection Restrictions

1. This connection requires a dual Audio/Video output on the DSS receiver.
2. Non-stereo VCR.
3. Stereo/surround unit must be on for DSS stereo sound.

Connection Benefits

1. DSS video to the VCR for better recording quality.
2. Can record one source while viewing the other.
3. DSS stereo sound to the stereo/surround unit.



* To record DSS and view antenna/cable: Put the VCR/TV button in TV mode. Make sure that the VCR is in line or video mode. Put the DSS/TV button in TV mode.

* To record antenna/cable and view DSS: Put the VCR on the channel you wish to record, Put the DSS/TV button in DSS mode and View using TV channel 3/4.
